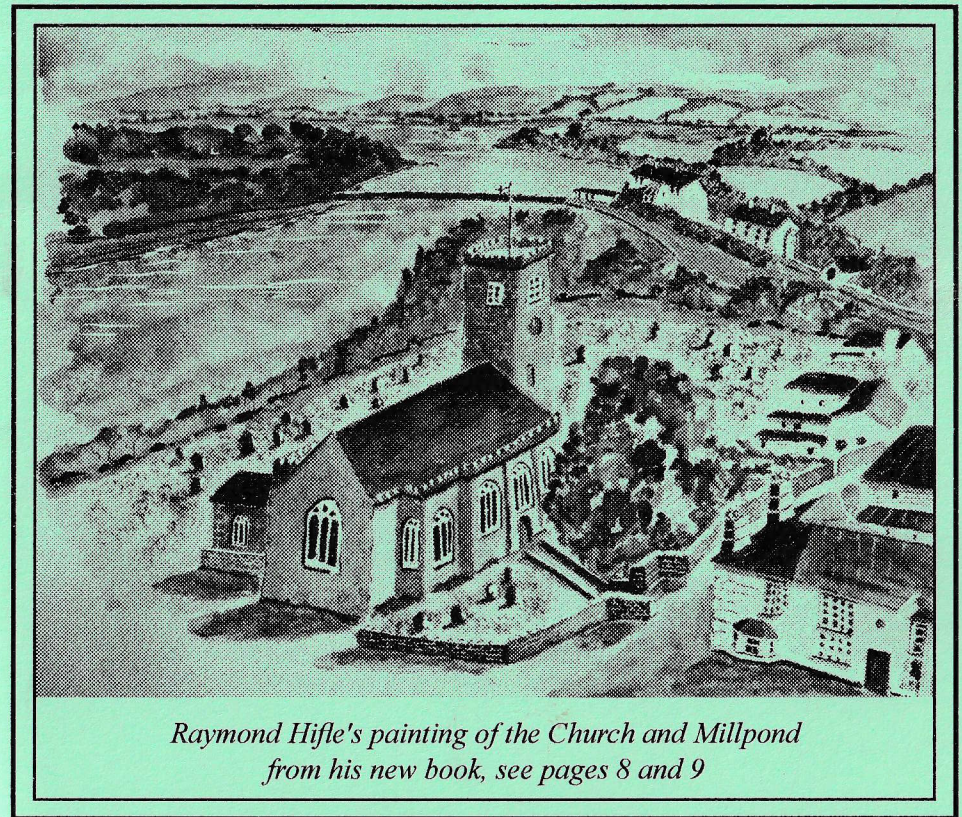

From the Revd Chris Martin

Dear friends,
This month's magazine may well land on your doormat on April Fool's day, which this year falls the day after Easter Sunday. It has reminded me of the times I have been called a fool for my faith, especially when I announced to my family and friends of my intention to quit my very well paid job in the financial training industry and train to become a Church of England vicar!

After all, by the world's standards, Jesus isn't what you might call 'a success.' He was born into poverty, was homeless for a while and then a refugee; he worked as a humble carpenter and was laughed at and scorned by many when his preaching and teaching ministry began; his life moved towards rejection and betrayal, even by his friends; his preferred mode of transport after walking was a donkey, rather than a horse; he endured suffering and torture, humiliation and abandonment, as he hung naked on a Roman cross on that first Good Friday; and he died friendless and penniless before being buried in an unmarked tomb borrowed from someone else. I can understand why some thought me foolish, and why some still do.

So why do people follow him? Why do sound-minded, clear-thinking people give up good jobs, change their plans and give their money away in support of this loser and his church? Why do hundreds of thousands still turn up at church in the UK on Sundays to sing of him, to pray and listen to him, to hear stories about him and to remember him in bread and wine? Why do more than two billion people across the world do likewise on Easter Sunday? What is it about him that attracts this sort of attention from men and women, rich and poor, old and young, the living and the dying, black or white, married or single, widowed or divorced, gay or straight?

If Jesus was on Instagram or X (Twitter), he'd easily have more followers than Kim Kardashian or Taylor Swift, or even Cristiano Ronaldo! The Bible which speaks of him has been the world's best-selling book for decades and has been translated into well over 2000 languages, 10 times more than any other book. Many will wonder whether it's foolish to follow him, or foolish not to. What do you think?

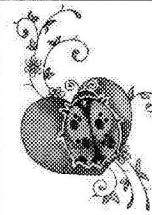

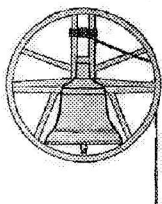

Stoke Gabriel Bell Ringers

Why does ringing stop during Holy Week?

In many churches, the bells are silenced during Holy Week as a sign of mourning and reflection. After the celebration of Palm Sunday (24th March this year), Holy Week commemorates the final days of Jesus Christ's life, including his crucifixion and death, until the bells ring out again in joy on Easter Day. Silencing the bells, especially in the latter half of the week, is symbolic of the solemnity of this period.

Easter Day 31 March

One of the most important dates for the church is Easter Day and ringers throughout the country made a special effort to ring the church bells.

Competitions well attended

On 2 March Bow held the intermediate ringing competition when 14 teams entered for two different sections. Each section was designed to appeal to developing ringers' skills.

The Devon Association novice competition was held on 9 March at Dunsford and 29 teams entered for the three different sections each designed for ringers of different abilities.

Totnes Deanery event at Diptford

On 16 March the Totnes Deanery held a competition at Diptford and this was followed by open ringing so that ringers of all abilities could ring with more experienced ringers. In the evening a social event was held at the nearby village hall that consisted of skittles and hot food.

Guild celebrate their 150th anniversary

To mark the 150th anniversary of the founding of the Guild of Devonshire Ringers, a celebration dinner held at The Devon Hotel, Old Matford Lane, Exeter on Friday 15 March 2024. After the dinner there was an auction of items such as an inscribed bell wheel, a footplate experience and ringing at Buckfast Abbey to raise funds.

Also to celebrate their anniversary was the launch of the revised and updated Guild history hardback book at Exeter St Petrock on Saturday 16 March. A programme of open ringing had also been arranged to precede the launch along with meeting the author, Lester Yea, and with him signing copies of the book.

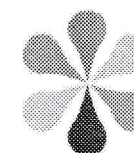

Ringling Out for Peace - 6 June 2024

The 6 of June 2024 marks the 80th anniversary of D-Day, when Allied forces mounted the largest amphibious invasion the world has ever witnessed. In 1944 Operation Overlord saw over 5,000 ships and landing craft set down more than 130,000 troops on five Normandy beaches in an action that would bring about the liberation of north-west Europe. As part of the 80th anniversary of the D-Day landings, ringers are being encouraged to Ring Out for Peace that day at 6.30pm or at another suitable time that day.

Ringling World National Youth Contest for those under 19

This year's Ringling World National Youth Contest is to be held in London on Saturday 6th July. Entries are open for teams to ring methods or call changes on six or eight. The headquarters will be St Mary-le-Bow and groups will have a bespoke itinerary to travel around central London for a full day's ringing, including a chance to ring on the great bells of Bow, where there will also be mini-rings and stalls. The results ceremony at the end of the day will be held in St Paul's Cathedral. Requests can also be made by a solo or small groups of young ringers who will be invited to join to a pre-existing group to enjoy a full day's schedule. Contestants must be aged under 19 on 31st August 2024.

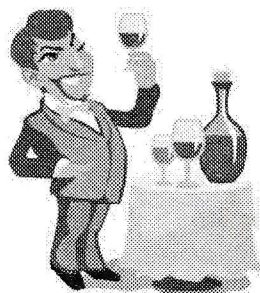

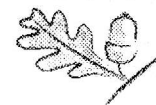

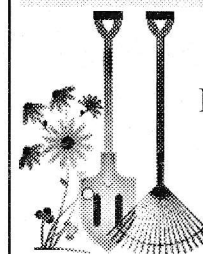

The story of Stoke Gabriel

An established Manor for several centuries before the Norman conquest, the Manor of Paignton included Marldon, Paignton and Stoke Gabriel, with the Bishop of Exeter becoming Lord of the Manor in 1050. His principle manorial residence was the Bishop's palace in Paignton. At the reformation, Henry VIII forced the bishop to sell the estate. Subsequent Lords of the Manor include four of the Earls of Pembroke and more recently, Sir Stafford Henry Northcote. All the Lords of the Manor became patrons of the church (giving them the right to choose the parish vicar) until the patronage was reacquired by the Bishop of Exeter in 1915.

Stoke Gabriel Church

Before the church was built, there was smaller chapel within the curtilage of the churchyard. There was no parish vicar at this time and services were led by the clergy of Paignton Church of St John the Baptist, the mother church of the chapel at the time.

The Norman church of Stoke Gabriel was built in the 13th century with funds from the Lord of the Manor. The establishment of the church coincided with the establishment of the parish and its boundaries. In the early 15th century, the church was rebuilt in a perpendicular Gothic style and included north and south aisles; only the tower remains from the 13th century building. The 15th century also saw the church provided with a font, rood screen and pulpit which survives to this day. During the 19th century, the Victorians undertook a major program of refurbishment including a new tiled floor, sanctuary, ceiling and roof, open access pews, the building of a lychgate and a "vicar's vestry". The church was originally dedicated to St Gabriel, that is the Archangel Gabriel, at the behest of the Bishop Bronescombe in the 13th century. The village was originally called Stoke, confusingly like many other villages up and down the country. The dedication of the church resulted in the adoption for the parish and the village of the more distinctive name Stoke Saint Gabriel (shortened over the centuries simply to Stoke Gabriel). At the time of the Victorian refurbishment of the church, the single dedication was changed to the joint one of St Mary and St Gabriel.

Another interesting fact about the church is the office of the sexton/verger has been handed down in the same family for thirteen generations, over four hundred years. Norman Betts the current verger is the last in line as there is no family to follow him. The traditional role of the sexton was to dig the graves in the churchyard.

The churchyard contains many graves, in fact thousands more than there are headstones. It was only in the 18th century that the use of headstones became fashionable. Prior to that, graves were marked by a wooden cross, the impermanence of which meant that their precise location was soon lost. New graves were dug above the existing graves with the consequence that the height of the ground of the church yard is greater than the surrounding land.

There is a famous yew tree believed to be over 1000 years old in the grounds of the church. These long-lived trees were often planted in holy places, so it could indicate how long the site has been occupied as a place of worship.

Legend states that if you walk backwards around it seven times you will have a wish granted. There is another younger yew tree in the north-east corner of the churchyard that was grown from a seed of the older yew tree and planted as a sapling in 2000 to commemorate the start of the new millennium.

A recent tradition of the church is the popular open - air service that is held each year on the quay at the end of carnival week. Blessed with good weather, it is a joyful occasion in a beautiful setting overlooking Mill Pool and river.

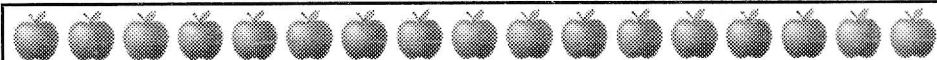

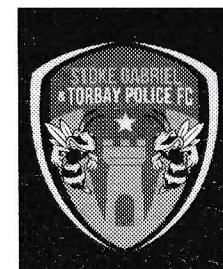

Stoke drivers deliver pickups

for Ukraine

A group of volunteer drivers, centred in Stoke Gabriel, delivered four pickup trucks and an SUV to Wroclaw in Poland in mid March as part of a charity drive to Ukraine. All the vehicles were sourced by the team, three of them were donated and the other two were financed by funds raised by the group via their JustGiving page: www.justgiving.com/page/ukraineneedstrucks. Seven drivers were involved in the trip, which started from the village and finished in western Poland, where Polish volunteers for the charity Ukrainian Action took the vehicles to the Ukrainian border, handing them to Ukrainian volunteers for the final leg to the war zone in the east.

All the vehicles were crammed full of aid: specialist firefighting equipment, medical supplies and mobility aids -- all donated to the group.

Many acts of kindness and support were experienced along the way, including a Crimean refugee who gave the team a free lunch at the end of their journey and a man who saw the charity stickers on the five vehicles and immediately thrust a roll of 500 euros in notes into one of the driver's hands as he passed. This was shared among the five Ukrainian drivers for fuel for their onward journey.

The team are hugely grateful for the support they have received from the village, including the enthusiastic response to the sale of logs, which has funded replacement batteries, clutches and other parts for the five vehicles in the convoy. Another convoy is planned in the late spring: the need in Ukraine sadly continues unabated.

War Memorial

A group of us (Pat Baker, George Collings, Richard Harris, Mark Hifle & Mike

Stott) has embarked on a project to identify as many Stoke Gabriel people as

possible who served in recent wars and to name them in a War Memorial Register.

Those identified will have resided in the parish of Stoke Gabriel at the time of their

enlistment or have had a significant association with it. In contrast to the names on

the War Memorial, it matters not how they died, whether it was a result of the

conflict or some natural cause; or where they died, whether it was at home or

abroad; or when they died, whether it was during the time of the conflict or later. It

matters only that they served their country, usually (but not exclusively) as a

member of one of the armed services. The wars include WW1 and WW2, and

more recent wars.

The aim is to produce a reference book with as much detail as possible about each

person and their service and then from that book to produce the Memorial Register

with key information, probably little more than their full name, regiment, war and

date of their death. The register would be permanently displayed with the pages

turned on a weekly basis whereas the reference book would be kept in a cupboard

for consultation should more information be required. Where known and with their

agreement, the reference book would also identify direct relatives of the

memorialised persons. The reference book would enable a short presentation about

the service of one or more persons each year on or around the time of

Remembrance Day, much as they do at Ypres and elsewhere.

The War Memorial Register would be displayed on a shelf with a glass top in a bespoke wooden unit made by a professional joiner, as befits its purpose.

This month Theresa our Vice President hosted our meeting. Members braved the miserable weather to enjoy a very informative talk by Charlotte Baker, a community liaison officer for South West Water. She came well equipped with a vast number of facts and figures about our local water supplier, their costs, income and future plans, plus where the water comes from and how waste water is dealt with.

It was interesting to discover that 90% of our water comes directly from extraction from the Dart. We all know that we have an influx of visitors in the Summer, but over the whole area covered by SW Water, the population rises from 2.2 million by a staggering 10 million on a yearly basis. So, within their plans, they also have to deal with this. She ended her talk by asking us to do our best to save water. I think we were all familiar with the various devices she was offering us, including a 4 minute timer to help us reduce the length of time we shower, new heads for the shower which aerate the water, so reducing the amount of water being used and bags for putting in the cistern to reduce the amount of water we flush. We also discussed fully the 3 outings which are being planned for our members over the coming Summer.

A back-stage visit to the **Palace Theatre, Paignton**, a coach outing and tour to **Powderham Castle** and our ever popular annual **canoe trip on the Dart**. Added to these are a **further 5 outings planned for our gardening group to local gardens, during the Spring and Summer.** *Why not come along and give us a go?*

The entries for the Register would be made by a professional calligrapher. Both the reference book and the Register would be designed to be updated as new information became available. The Parish Council has generously agreed to fund the construction of the wooden display unit, memorial book and calligraphy.

The location for the display unit would be in the parish church but its precise location is still to be determined. Digital versions of the reference book and the memorial register could also be made available on-line via the Parish Council and Parish Church web sites. It is hoped that the display unit containing the Memorial Register could be installed by Remembrance Day 2024. In the meantime, if you have an ancestor who served in one of the wars, especially WW2, and who has a significant association with the parish, then **please let one of us know** if you would like them to be remembered in this way, providing us with their full name, regiment, war and the date of their death as a minimum.
