

From the Revd Chris Martin

Dear friends.

If October was a month for saying 'Thank you', then November is the month for 'Remembering.' It begins on the 1st with the marking of All Saints Day, a Lachance to remember the wonderful men and women who have gone before us and inspired us in their Christian living. Living in Stoke Gabriel as we do, one can hardly forget to 'Remember, remember the 5th November' with all the wonderful festivities that accompany bonfire night in the village. Then, on Remembrance Sunday, we remember again the bravery of those who gave their lives for the freedom we so often take for granted today. My own father died at the end of one November many years ago, and so the month has added 'remembering' poignancy for me. In the Christian tradition, 'remembering' is important. God gave instructions to his Old Testament people to keep the Sabbath, a weekly block of time enabling us to re-orientate ourselves towards God and to remember who God is and who we are. God gave commands to perform certain rituals and observe particular festivals commemorating some of the mighty acts of God in the past, to help God's people remember for generation after generation. These days, Sunday by Sunday, in the village church and across the whole world, we partake of those simple yet very powerful symbols of bread and wine as we seek to follow Christ's command to 'Do this in remembrance of me,' and saying together the Church's seasonal liturgy, which is such a helpful aid to remembering and experiencing afresh the deep truths of God. One of the things I notice about my own faith journey is how 'forgetful' I am. I don't mean those occasions when I go into a room for something and can't remember what (though that seems to happen with increasing regularity too!). I mean I am quick to forget that I am loved, that I am enough, that my life matters, that my life has both purpose and meaning, that I am forgiven. I often forget and lose my sense of true 'self'. So it is good to find ways of remembering together who we are and how much we are loved, as this helps to put us back together again - 're-membered' if you like. Whatever you are remembering this month, may you know too the remembrance of how much you are known and loved by the One who holds us all.

Bellringing News

Church Clock

The church clock stopped again recently, first on a Sunday. After resetting it, it stopped again the following day. The clock hands were left at their stopping point, about twenty to eight, to help the technicians from Smiths of Derby diagnose the issue! Hopefully, by the time you read this, the clock mechanism will have been replaced, ensuring everything is in full working order

ahead of the clock change at the end of October.

Ringing for Remembrance Sunday – 10 November

The National Service of Remembrance, held at The Cenotaph in Whitehall, honours all who have served and sacrificed. British and Commonwealth soldiers, sailors, airmen and women, along with emergency services and civilians, are remembered to ensure that no one is forgotten.

On Sunday, 10 November, we plan to ring from 10:00 to 10:50 ahead of the 10:55 Remembrance Sunday service. The National Service of Remembrance will also take place at the Cenotaph in London, starting at 11:00. It will commemorate the contributions of British and Commonwealth servicemen and women, both military and civilian, from the two world wars and later conflicts.

The public can watch the ceremony from the pavements along Whitehall and Parliament Street (though entry may be limited if the area becomes full). You can also watch the service on BBC, Sky, or ITV.

Remembrance Sunday is a national opportunity to honour those who have defended our freedoms and protected our way of life.

Ringing on the Six Bells at Kingswear

Our ringers have been busy ringing the six bells at Kingswear. Originally, there were three bells, but they have been augmented to a peal of six. The new treble is the Peace Bell, appropriately introduced in time for Remembrance Sunday. This bell was generously funded by Gary Lewis in memory of his father, who was an evacuee to Kingswear from London. The second bell commemorates the Coronation of King Charles III, and the third celebrates Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee.

You can watch a 10-minute moving YouTube clip relating to the background of raising funds for the bells and the journey of the bells to Kingswear.





This week our speaker was Nick Powe, former owner of Kent's Cavern. He shared with us his enthusiasm for these caves, which he inherited from 4 previous generations of his family. It had been owned by them for more than a century, only passing into new hands last year. Nick's interest expanded to include the Torbay geopark, of which the caves are a major part. The caves were formed in the past 2.5 million years, by an underground river. The earliest human remains, a jaw-bone, dating back about 41,000 years makes it the site of the oldest relic of *homo sapiens* in the country.

We also focussed on our upcoming Christmas Fayre to be held on 30th November, in the Village hall. Members of the WI, plus others who wish to, will run stalls with Christmas in mind. Book of Remembrance for the Service Men and Women of Stoke Gabriel



This year Remembrance Sunday will mark the first anniversary of the project team set up after last year's service to try and identify all those from the Parish who served in WW1 & 2, and subsequent wars, yet were not recorded on the village War Memorial. Many villagers served in the wars were lucky enough to return fit but other were not so fortunate and came back injured or permanently scarred by the horrors of war.

The Book will record the bravery of all who have resided in the Parish so that their sacrifice is not forgotten.

Mike Stott and his team have so far identified 155 names for inclusion in the Book. A summary of their service has also been recorded, where they served and more tragically where and when they died, and also of their place of residence and occupation.



Another extract from Ray Hifle's illustrated book about the village:



The Old Vicarage

From the earliest times Stoke Gabriel was provided with a vicarage in which the parish Priest would reside. The original building has long since gone, but it was known to be located adjacent to the churchyard, probably on the north side: an inference that can be drawn from the litigation between the priest (Revd Daniel Getsius) and the Church wardens in the early 17th century as to whether the garden of the vicarage encroached on the churchyard, in the absence of a boundary wall at the time. In another lawsuit at about the same time, there was a successful challenge that the vicarage was part of the manorial estate acquired by the Earl of Pembroke from the Bishop of Exeter pursuant to the order of Henry VIII. As a result, for the next 250 years the parish had no vicarage, obliging the parish priests to use rented accommodation, including Rosemount and The Castle. Towards the end of the 19th century, however, the Diocese agreed to build a new vicarage and the then parish priest, Rev'd John Henry Napper Neville, moved into his new residence in what became known as Vicarage Road. The vicar was a tall handsome man and there were several spinsters in the area who were much attracted to him. One such lady was Miss Durant of Sharpham House, who reportedly installed a special window to enable her to gaze across the Dart in his direction. However, this was to no avail. Thereafter the vicarage was occupied by a succession of priests until the present, purpose-built and more central vicarage in School Hill was built in the 1960s, and the Old Vicarage was acquired by the Gillmore family.



The Gabriel Court was originally known as Hill House. The site was for over 450 years the home of the local squires, the Churchward family, and in that time has played a small part in the events of national significance. William of Orange reputedly spent his first night in England at Hill House after landing at Brixham in 1688. In an earlier age Sir Walter Raleigh's navigator, John Davis, on the first night of his return from America, did "retire to Hill House to partake of the tobacco plant", one of the first occasions that tobacco was smoked in England. The building was substantially altered in the 1540s, but was little changed when the house was completely remodelled and a new façade added. The last Churchward family left in the early 1920s whereupon Hill House became a hotel. Restored and converted, and operating as the Gabriel Court Hotel, it became a much-loved centre of village life, It now enters a new phase of its history as part of Gabriel Court housing development.

Thanks to Ray for two more extracts from his excellent book about the village, illustrated with his watercolour paintings (have you got your copy?)

Do watch the youtube film about the bells travelling from John Taylor's bellfoundry at Loughborough to Kingswear (see page 5.) The story of the evacuee reminded me of being put on a train at Bristol, aged 10, and sent to stay with my aunt at Kingswear. In those pre-Beeching days the steam train went from Bristol to Kingswear with no changes! That moment when the train puffs out of the Greenway tunnel and the Dart comes into view — magical.


