

Dear friends,





Bell Ringing News

Stoke Gabriel Bells Featured on BBC Radio 4's "Bells on Sunday"

Stoke Gabriel's bells recently had a moment of national recognition when they were featured on BBC Radio 4's "Bells on Sunday" programme on 8 September. Several listeners from our community were quick to notice and inform me of the broadcast—congratulations to all who caught it!

While we are unsure exactly which recording of the ringing was used, as submissions had been made in the past, it was a moment of pride for our bell ringers and community to hear Stoke Gabriel's bells on the airwaves. The timing of the broadcast was particularly special, as that weekend coincided with the Annual General Meeting of the Central Council of Bell Ringers, who held this meeting in Exeter to celebrate the 150th anniversary of the Guild of Devonshire Ringers. It was an honour to have our bells featured during such a significant event, and we hope the unique sound of the church bells at Stoke Gabriel continues to resonate with listeners far and wide.

Learning to ring at Stoke Gabriel

The ringing team at Stoke Gabriel now includes a returning ringer and a new learner. Regardless of age, everyone progresses at their own pace, depending on the time they can dedicate to practicing the necessary skills. Thanks to our dedicated and loyal team of ringers, the bells are generally heard every Sunday for the main morning service. We are fortunate to have enough ringers to keep the bells ringing, but we warmly welcome anyone interested in learning this ancient art, distinctive to Britain, to give it a try. Should you wish for more details about learning to ring, please do not hesitate to contact me, see below, or call in to the church whenever you hear the bells ringing.

Stoke Gabriel Ringers at Dartmouth Regatta

Several of our ringers participated in the Dartmouth Regatta at St Saviour's over three days at the end of August. Stoke Gabriel ringers have proudly supported the Regatta every year since the 1960s. This year's Regatta featured the usual lineup of events, including sailing, rowing, crabbing, and swimming, along with activities in Coronation Park and Royal Avenue Gardens. The event also included tennis, road races, fancy dress, craft stalls, live music, and entertainment for all ages, especially children. The Regatta concluded with a fireworks display on Saturday night.

Totnes Deanery Winter League

Before the pandemic, the Totnes Deanery Bell Ringers organised a Winter League, This offered a great opportunity to hone our skills, while also supporting developing ringers who wanted to improve their technique. We held striking competitions within a smaller, local area, making it easier to travel during the colder months and giving us a chance to meet and socialise with ringers from nearby churches. These meetings were not solely focused on competition ringing. 

.....and rope lengths—something that varies considerably across the Totnes Deanery. Although no official announcement has been made about the return of these events, I believe the social aspect of bell ringing will likely encourage the revival of the Totnes Deanery Winter League, with meetings anticipated from October through to March.

Centenary Anniversary of Devon Association

The Devon Association of Ringers, of which we subscribe to, will celebrate its 100th anniversary in 2025, and the Committee is planning several events throughout the year to mark this milestone. The first proposed event is Devon-Wide Ringing on Saturday, May 31st. With 150 affiliated towers, the hope is to exceed 100 participating towers. A further proposed event is to hold the 2025 Major Final at Zeal Monachorum in June, the location of the first Competition Final in 1925. Final arrangements will be presented for approval at the Association's AGM on November 9th.

St Thomas' Kingswear augmented to 6 bells

The Friends of St Thomas Church, along with the Kingswear Parochial and Parish Councils, are thrilled to announce the arrival of three new bells for St Thomas Church, which were delivered by train to Kingswear Station on Sunday, 15th September. The eight bells of St Saviour's Dartmouth were rung, with the assistance of our own ringers, to celebrate the final part of the journey for the three new bells via the Dartmouth Steam Railway. The original three bells, weighing 9 cwt, hang in a cast iron and steel "H" frame designed for six bells. This frame was installed in 1939 when Taylor's recast the tenor and rehung the bells with all new fittings. The three new bells were placed on display inside the church for several days after delivery and the church was opened daily until 7:00 pm on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday, allowing visitors to see the bells before they were installed in the tower. Fundraising for this project was led by The Friends of St Thomas Church, Originally, the effort began to commemorate the late Queen's Platinum Jubilee, but as time passed, it evolved into a celebration of the Coronation of King Charles III. A special thanks goes to Gary Lewis, whose generous donation funded the purchase of a Peace Bell in memory of Thomas William Lewis, an evacuee. After the successful installation, please do listen out for the sound of six bells ringing across the River Dart from Kingswear for the first time since the tower was built in 1173. A group of our local bell ringers rang a celebratory peal on the Kingswear church bells on 26th September.

Kingswear is now eager to welcome anyone interested in learning to ring the church bells. You don't need to be a churchgoer—if you're interested, please contact the undersigned for more information.
